

SUGGESTIONS TO GENERATE INTEREST FOR LIFE CHAIN

1. CHURCH PUBLICATIONS-

Check with your church's office staff to learn publication guidelines and deadlines for the church calendar, newsletter and weekly church bulletin. Submit entries in a timely manner for publication.

2. CHURCH BULLETIN INSERTS-

LocalLifeChain.com has bulletin inserts that can be downloaded and copied. Just click "Bulletin Inserts" and print. Fill in the blanks with your church's assigned location, your name and phone number and copy. There are bulletin inserts for the weeks leading up to Life Chain and for Life Chain Sunday.

3. CHURCH BULLETIN BOARDS -

LocalLifeChain.com has bulletin board flyers that can be downloaded and copied. Just click "Bulletin Board Flyer" and print. Fill in the blanks with your church's assigned location, your name and phone number and copy. All Ways Graphics has designed some really great looking posters for Life Chain.

4. ANNOUNCEMENTS ABOUT LIFE CHAIN-

Ask for time to promote Life Chain during the announcements time of your worship service. Ask Sunday School teachers to make an announcement about Life Chain in their classes. A copy of the bulletin insert would be helpful for those making the announcements.

5. PRAYER-

Prayer is so critical to the success of Life Chain. If your church has a prayer team, ask them to commit to pray for Life Chain and for your church's involvement in Life Chain. Ask your Sunday School class to commit to pray also.

6. YOUTH / TEEN INVOLVEMENT-

Some churches might have more youth / teen participation if they plan Life Chain in tandem with some other activity either before or after Life Chain, possibly with a sister church's youth / teen group. Speak with your church's youth / teen pastor or leader about this.

7. PASTOR INVOLVEMENT-

The sheep will follow the shepherd. Remind your pastor / priest of the importance of their support for Life Chain from the pulpit, and their participation in Life Chain. The church will turn out if their shepherd challenges them and then leads by example.
